#### **Photography and Collaboration**

To coincide with the launch of MA Photography and Collaboration, Coventry University will host the annual summer conference for the association of photographers in higher education (APHE), in July 2019. This is an opportunity to lead discussions around new ways of thinking through photography as a collaborative practice both online, within the classroom and as socially engaged artists. During the conference we will be hosting a mixture of artists talks, open call participation panels, discussions on pedagogy and sign up workshops to circulate these ideas.

**Call for Papers:** For this conference, we are inviting 20-minute presentations by members to present on one of two themes:

#### *Working with Online Communities*

As we, together with our students, grapple with the pragmatics and possibilities of photography transformed through linked digital technologies, so too as educators we must think about the altered state of the classroom. We invite presentations which consider hybrid, generative and post-digital pedagogies in photographic education regardless of their success. It is planned that in an open and frank discussion we might take away small, practical ideas to embed in our own institutions.

#### *Collaboration as a Pedagogy*

Learning is increasingly viewed as a platform for social change in society. It is seen to have the potential to support the exploration of personal experiences with the aim of enhancing efficacy and social cohesion. With an emphasis on participation and communities of practice, we invite submissions that challenge traditional teaching and learning models within the photographic discipline. This is an opportunity to share your working methods within the wider photographic teaching and learning community and open up conversations around participation as a pedagogy.
